ROTARY MINUTE – APRIL 11, 2018

ROTARIAN MAGAZINE

Most of us look forward to receiving the monthly Rotary magazine. Its quality has ebbed and flowed over the years, but under Editor John Rezek's stewardship it's been consistently interesting and informative. (Rezek, by the way, is an alumnus of *Playboy Magazine*, another Chicago institution.)

Reproduced here is the very first issue, published in July, 1911. It was called *The National Rotarian* then, and included an essay by Paul Harris entitled "The Rational Rotarian" on its front cover. Also included were club news and a few paid advertisements. 2,000 copies were printed, and it proved so popular that another 2,000 were soon ordered up.

Our magazine's name was changed and simplified to *The Rotarian* in 1912, and it's been keeping Rotarians around the world informed and engaged ever since.
