# ROTARY MINUTE – APRIL 25, 2018

## CELL PHONES SAVE LIVES IN PAKISTAN

Rotary and its partners in the **GLOBAL POLIO ERADICATION INITIATIVE** are strengthening communications by giving cell phones to health workers in Pakistan. Rotary has been working to replace paper-based reporting of maternal and child care information with mobile phone and e-monitoring technology. Program organizers plan to distribute 5,000 cell phones in 2018.

Health workers can use the phones to send data via text messages to a central server. If they see a potential polio case they can immediately alert officials at Pakistan's National Emergency Operations Center. The result is a collection of real time information that officials can easily monitor and access.


Health workers also use mobile phones to monitor a multitude of maternal and child care issues. Health officials, including community midwives are tracking pregnant mothers. When a child is born they can input and maintain complete health records for basic health care and hygiene needs. Pakistan's child mortality rate is among the highest in the world. Rotary's cell phone project and mobile technology will undoubtedly make a difference!
