ROTARY MINUTE – DECEMBER 13, 2017

India was declared polio free in 2013 and has remained so ever since. But efforts to keep it that way must continue. On January 18, 2018 Sunrise Rotarian Chris Steinkrauss will arrive in New Delhi, India, to participate in India's annual National Immunization Day, a part of Rotary's ongoing effort to rid the world of Polio. Her travels will take her to Agra, Jaipur, Chandigarh and back to New Delhi, and will include a cycle rickshaw ride, an elephant ride and a trip to the Taj Mahal.



While in India Chris will stay primarily as a guest in local Rotarians' homes. She'll visit facilities of the World Health Organization, UNICEF, and the Polio Plus offices in India. And of course she'll participate with hundreds – perhaps thousands – of Rotarians distributing polio vaccine to local children on National Immunization Day.

There are 26 Rotarians representing 13 Districts in her team. Chris says she's looking forward to working – and having fun – with the group, and to learning a lot more about the fight against polio in India. She promises to share her experiences with us when she returns. Sunrise Rotarians wish Chris every success on her adventure-some journey.
