### WATER AND SANITATION SCHOLARSHIPS



Last month The Rotary Foundation announced the establishment of scholarships intended to help advance the world's access to clean water. The scholarships will provide funding for graduate students at the IHE Delft Institute for Water Education in Delft, The Netherlands, the world's largest international graduate water education facility. Scholarships are available in pursuit of a degree in one of three Master of Science programs: Urban Water and Sanitation, Water Management and Water and Science Engineering.

The Delft Institute has provided graduate education to more than 15,000 water professional in 162 countries, most of them from the developing world. It offers a unique combination of applied, scientific and participatory research in water engineering, and counts Rotary International and UNESCO among its partners. Scholarships are available to qualified applicants sponsored by individual Rotary Clubs and their Districts.

Even today, one in three people worldwide lacks access to an adequate toilet; one in ten lacks access to clean water; and every twenty seconds a child dies because of poor sanitation. It's Rotary's goal that everyone have access to clean water – a basic human right – by 2030.
